### Present

<b>I</b>	deluge
<b>you</b>	deluge
<b>he/she/it</b>	deluges
<b>we</b>	deluge
<b>you</b>	deluge
<b>they</b>	deluge

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am deluging
<b>you</b>	are deluging
<b>he/she/it</b>	is deluging
<b>we</b>	are deluging
<b>you</b>	are deluging
<b>they</b>	are deluging

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	deluged
<b>you</b>	deluged
<b>he/she/it</b>	deluged
<b>we</b>	deluged
<b>you</b>	deluged
<b>they</b>	deluged

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was deluging
<b>you</b>	were deluging
<b>he/she/it</b>	was deluging
<b>we</b>	were deluging
<b>you</b>	were deluging
<b>they</b>	were deluging

### Present perfect
